Putting waste to good use.

More than 50% of our fiberglass and steel door end rails are made from **90% recycled or scrap material**.

Most of our scrap lite frame material is reused to make new lite frames.

Leftover material cut out of the door for glass inserts **is reused as insulation** for barns, animal shelters, utility buildings, and more.

Leaving a smaller footprint.

In 2022, we diverted over 15 million pounds of waste otherwise destined for landfills.

Our Veris™ collection door systems are assembled at our facility in Pine Grove, Pennsylvania, which gets 60% of its power from renewable energy generated by on-site solar panels.
