




ART DECO

- The TruStile Art Deco door styles combine modern European design ideas introduced in France with the romance of 1930s Hollywood.



SPANISH COLONIAL







- TruStile's Traditional series reflects the classic and historic design ideas of an earlier time and place.



- The ornate nature of the TruStile Victorian door line effectively reproduces this historic time period within your home.



Rather than placing two matching doors side by side, common arch pairs carry details, such as curved panels and rails, across both doors. The end result? The doors actually look like they were made for the opening. Common arch pairs are also available with arch and radius tops.








